However, the Bishops of the United States have said that when this feast falls on either Saturday or a Monday, those years gridy's **NOT** a Holy Day of Obligation.

So, this year, there is no obligation to attend Mass on New Year's Day. However, for those who wish to, we will have Mass on Monday, January 1, 2018, at 9:00 am and at 12:15 pm. There will be no anticipatory Mass in the parish on New Year's Eve.


